AWARDS OF THE SOCIETY OF MEDICAL BIOCHEMISTS OF SERBIA

On the basis of Article 47 of its Statute, *Diplomas* or *Certificates of Appreciation* are awarded by the Society of Medical Biochemists of Serbia (formerly Yugoslavia) to its members, medical biochemists, and other individuals or legal entities, in acknowledgement of their contribution to the promotion of medical biochemistry as a profession and a scientific discipline. Foreign experts who have contributed to the development and work of the Society or the promotion of medical biochemistry and laboratory medicine are awarded *Honorary Diplomas* by the Society.

Before 1998, the first DIPLOMAS OF THE SMBY were presented to: *Prof. Dr Pavle Trpinac, Primarius Tatjana Plećaš-Drljača* (on the occasion of the 40th anniversary of the Society of Medical Biochemists of Yugoslavia, she was also awarded an Honorary Diploma of the SMBY) and *Primarius Ružica Mašić*.
